This experiential workshop will explore how, with only the simple tools of compasses and square, the tools of the freemason, patterns can be drawn that can be easily developed into the working drawings for some of the great cathedrals and ancient monuments of the western world. We will feel and look at what makes a space 'sacred', and how we can replicate that in our own homes, our gardens or in the landscape. In the course of the day, we will create our own rose windows, gothic arches, and set out the geometry on the land for our own flattened Type B stone circle. No mathematical knowledge is needed, just an open mind and a willingness to have fun.

THE ENCHANTMENT OF OLYMPIC LONDON

Those who have been able to attend the London Conferences are learning how London has deep and complex traditions of myth, legend and history overlaying an essentially magical and sacred landscape with many power points and sacred sites. At the time of the Olympic Games of 2012, the midwinter sunrise is approximately aligned with the Galactic Centre, which happens for a short time period of approximately thirty-six years only once every 26,000 years. For the next three years, the Gatekeeper Trust will continue the series of London-based meetings and pilgrimages. These events are exploring the significance of London and its context within Britain, Europe and the world from the point of view of ancient traditions, legends, mythology, prophecies, sacred landscape, geomancy, cosmology, history, culture, architecture, town planning, and the Freemasonic, Rosicrucian, Christian and pre-Christian gnosis.

A small, illustrated booklet based on these pilgrimages and presentations, and outlining the basic scheme of the London Mysteries, will be produced in 2011, and will be available for sale to Olympic visitors by the late Spring of 2012.
